

Be your REAL ID self by May 3, 2023

ARE YOU READY?

REAL ID Implementation Date Now May 3, 2023

The enforcement date for REAL ID was changed from October 1, 2021 to May 3, 2023. Please remember that beginning May 3, 2023, to fly domestically, U.S. travelers must be Real ID compliant to board domestic flights. Delaware began issuing Real ID compliant driver licenses and identification cards in 2010. Pennsylvania also issues Real ID compliant driver licenses, although a one-time additional cost is required. 
