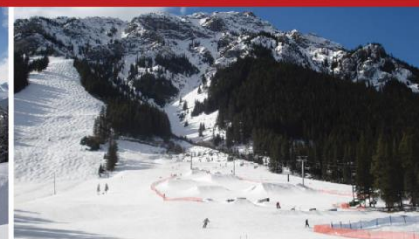
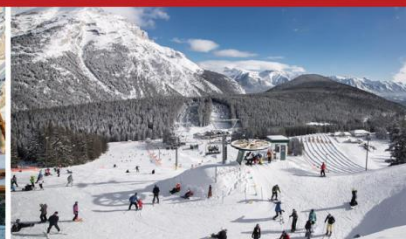
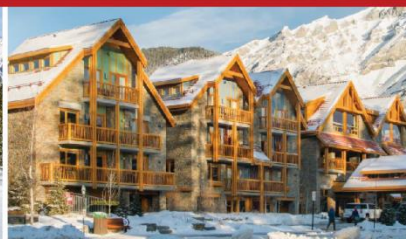

SKI RACING

The Mid-Atlantic Masters race season begins Friday and Saturday, Jan 6 and 7, 2023 at Hunter Mtn, NY. Giant Slalom (GS) is on Friday and Slalom (SL) is on Saturday.

Sunday, Jan 22 is a “two-fer”, GS race and SL race at Montage, PA. This is a fun race. Two races in one day. There is a tail gate party after the race.

The Eastern Regional Masters Championships are hosted by New England Masters at Stratton, VT Wed, Jan 25 to Sat. Jan 28. New England Masters, New York Masters and Mid-Atlantic Masters are hosting races at several mountains in NY, MA and CT, Thur, Feb 2 to Sun, Feb 5. Mid-Atlantic Masters is hosting races at West Mtn, NY Fri, Feb 17 to Sun, Feb 19. The Mid-Atlantic Masters Championship Races are Fri, Mar 3 to Sun, Mar 5 at Gore Mtn, NY.

For less serious racing there is also NASTAR racing and EPSC has a race series. These are “fun races”. “Fun” means you can get away with skidding your turns – you won’t go as fast, but so what.

Last winter there were good turnouts of local racers at the Tuesday and Wednesday night NASTAR races at Bear Creek. Bear Creek is only about an hour north of Wilmington on PA 100. I expect Bear Creek will continue with NASTAR. It gets a good draw for skiing and in the bar after skiing (for settling of beer bets and claiming bragging rights).

Last year EPSC had a series of three club races. Unfortunately, Wilmington did not participate. This year I am hoping to get a team for at least one race.

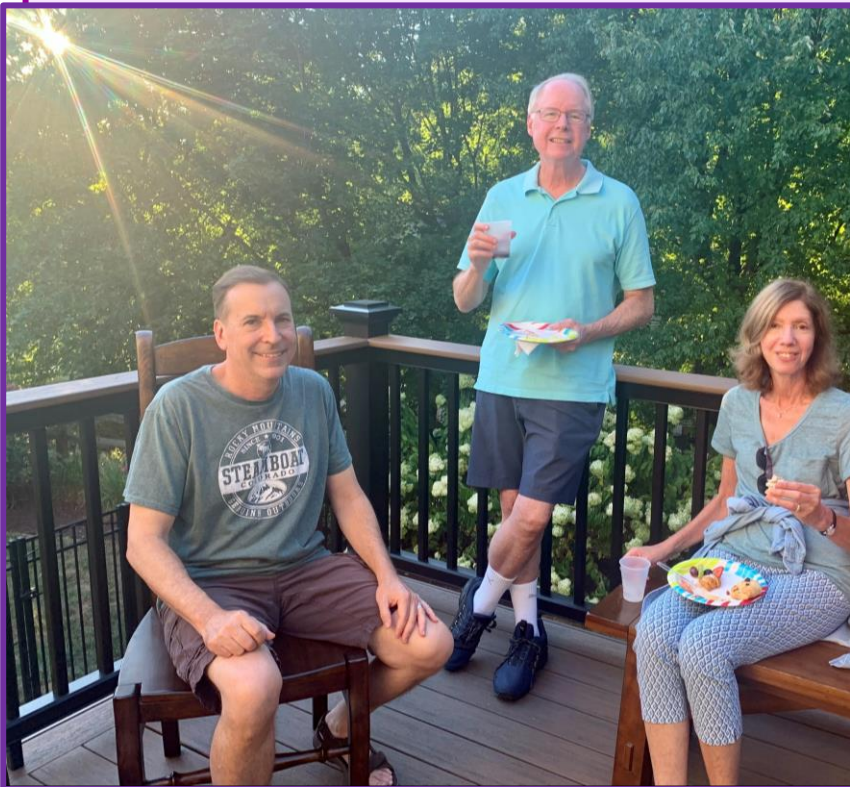

MEET YOUR NEW ID. THE ONE THAT'S READY TO FLY.

Be your REAL ID self by **May 3, 2023**

ARE YOU READY?

REAL ID Implementation Date Now May 3, 2023

The enforcement date for REAL ID was changed from October 1, 2021 to May 3, 2023. Please remember that beginning **May 3, 2023**, to fly domestically, U.S. travelers must be Real ID compliant to board domestic flights. Delaware began issuing Real ID compliant driver licenses and identification cards in 2010. Pennsylvania also issues Real ID compliant driver licenses, although a one-time additional cost is required.
