For those who may ski only one trip next year, there is an article in this issue about the Epic Day Pass that might be helpful.

While I'm on the subject of next year's trips, your Club's Council has modified the sign-up process to make it fairer to all members. This year, we'll use the postmark of the trip application mailing as the primary determining factor in signups. Applications must be postmarked by either US Postal Service or an overnight delivery service (e.g. FedEx.) The

postmark must be no sooner than the first date of trip availability. As an example, if a trip opens on June 1st, applications must be postmarked no earlier than June 1. Remember that Continuous Members (paid members for at least the previous two Club years) have first access to trips.

We have activities coming up. There is a Happy Hour at 1937 Brewing Company at Delaware Park on Thursday, April 13 starting at 4 pm. The first Home Happy Hour of the Season is Friday, May 5 at Frank Maderich's.

We'll have a group at the 45th Annual Point-To-Point on Sunday, May 7. Please check the weekly WSC email and the website for more information. If you have an idea for an event you'd like to host, please contact [Lois Morris](#).

2024 EPIC Pass Sale Started in March 2023 (plan to buy yours now)

It's not really an epic adventure to select the right pass for next season.

As you know, the Club's 2024 North American ski trips are all to ski areas operated by Vail Resorts. Accordingly, Whistler Blackcomb (January 20-27,) Vail (February 3-10,) and Heavenly (March 16-23) all accept the Epic Pass®. And for our European trip, Madonna di Campiglio (March 1-12) accepts the full Epic Pass as well. Indeed, you may well find it less expensive to use some version of an Epic Pass than trying to buy tickets directly from the resorts.

But you may be thinking, "I only plan to go on one of the trips next year and I don't think that a full-blown Epic Pass will be right for me." That is certainly a reasonable concern. But the good news is that the Epic Pass program has a variety of pass options, from a single day for one resort to up to 7 days at each of over 40 locations.

Probably you know about the full **Epic Pass**; 7 days of skiing, over 40 resorts, no blackout dates. Or, maybe you've considered the **Epic Local Pass** that gets you 5 days at most of those resorts but with some restrictions, such as holiday blackouts or 10 combined days at Whistler Blackcomb, Vail, and Beaver Creek. But did you know about the **Epic Day Pass**?

The Epic Day Pass might be right for you.

Depending on which trip you go on, you may find that the **Epic Day Pass** will fit your needs. Quoting from *epicpass.com*, "The Epic Day Pass can be customized to fit your plans for the season. You can build your own pass based on the number of days you plan to ski or ride (1-7), whether you

want access on restricted days, and how many resorts you want access to (All resorts, 32 resorts, or 22 resorts). You can use your days when you want throughout the season – they do not have to be consecutive."

To help you figure out which option is best for you, the Epic Pass website has a tool to assist. Go to the [Epic Pass](#) website and select the *Passes* dropdown list and then select **Epic Pass**. You will see a description of the pass options. Scroll down to "Not Finding the Pass for You?" and there's a link for "View All Passes." Check out the section on **Epic Day Pass**. You'll see a tool to help you select the right option. And remember that an **Epic Day Pass** allows you to ski at a variety of the Epic resorts, not just one. So, you could ski several days on one of our North American trips and save a day or two for something in Pennsylvania, Vermont or New Hampshire. The tool is quite helpful. You just need to identify where you want to ski and how many days.

Again, if you think you will ski more than 7 days, then an **Epic Local Pass** or a full **Epic Pass** may be right for you. Remember, though, that while **Epic Pass** products have just gone on sale, historically, the prices have increased as we get closer to the season. So, you may save some money by deciding sooner rather than later where you want to ski next season.



****NEW** WSC TRIP MEMBER APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS**

Implementation: March 2023

Given the popularity of WSC trips, Council believes it is important to establish a clear trip application process in order to make the process fair for all members. This process will also provide our trip leaders with a consistent process.

Please carefully review the information below for a list of changes and some highlights.

1) Postmark

ALL applications **must be** Postmarked (or an express delivery ship date). Postmark will be the date used to determine how applications are considered, not date received.

2) Date Trip Opens (publicized sign-up date)

The earliest Postmark date is the publicized “Date Trip Opens” or sign-up date.

3) Early Applications

Any applications Postmarked before the “Date Trip Opens” will be deemed postmarked 2 days after the “Date Trip Opens”.

4) Complete Application

To be considered timely, an application must include all the necessary documents. A checklist has been created to assist. Important: An incomplete submission may delay or disqualify your application for the trip.

Subject to availability – Return September 19**

Anita O'Donnell with Cruise Planners has offered to put together a bike and barge tour beginning in Belgium ending up in Amsterdam in Holland. Currently, there are 11 cabins for 22 people; however, availability may change. VBT Bicycling Vacations (Williston, VT) is the vendor.

We are advertising this trip to Wilmington Ski Club members and guests. This is not an officially sanctioned trip from the WSC, so you won't be signing waivers of liability with WSC, and your arrangements for this trip will be made with VBT through Cruise Planners. Your tour leader is VBT, and they will take care of airfare, the trip details, and transfers for transportation if you select airfare with them. You will have two tour guides with VBT during the barge portion of the trip.

You have three options:

1. **AIR PACKAGE:** VBT books your international air from PHL; roundtrip transfers are included, 2 nights in a Bruges 4-star hotel; 1 night in an Amsterdam hotel at the end of the trip; see LAND ONLY for the remainder of the package description. The air package is **\$5645** from Philadelphia per person double occupancy. Quotes from most major airports are available (price will change based on Gateway) and you may extend your trip.
2. **OWN AIR:** You book your own air, but participate in the full 11-day vacation; this option is **\$4876** per person, double occupancy. Refer to LAND ONLY for the remainder of the vacation.
3. **LAND ONLY PACKAGE:** 7 nights aboard a private canal barge, 15 meals (7 breakfasts, 3 lunches, 5 dinners); 2 bilingual tour guides, support vehicle, bike and helmet, facilitated cultural experiences. Price is **\$4295** per person, double occupancy, no extensions allowed.

Deposit of \$500 per person is due before December 1; balance of trip (including air) is due May 5.
The air package is a good deal. When you purchase your own air, your purchase it immediately.

If you choose to purchase your own air, do not do so until you have been confirmed by VBT.
