## RED GOES GREEN PHILLIES

**TIME IS RUNNING OUT TO SIGN UP FOR THIS TERRIFIC EVENT! THERE'S STILL ROOM FOR MORE VOLUNTEERS.**

Spread the word to your Ski Club about volunteering for this year's Red Goes Green Phillies game! Your club members can also learn about this event on the EPSC website: [www.easternpaskicouncil.org](http://www.easternpaskicouncil.org)

This year will be the third year in a row EPSC has participated. Be part of this very special and FUN event!

The Philadelphia Phillies ask organizations in the area to form "Red Goes Green" teams (maximum 100 people on a team) to help in their recycling efforts by collecting recyclable plastic and aluminum bottles during Phillies home games. Only one "Red Goes Green" team is assigned to each game.

EPSC is organizing a volunteer team supporting the Philadelphia Phillies "Red Goes Green" initiative. This year's game is confirmed for Sunday July 24, Phillies vs. Padres.

Sunday games typically start around 1:00 in the afternoon, but they have not designated the exact time yet. You will be notified when the time is determined. All volunteers must be at the Citizen's Bank Park about an hour and a half before game time.

Our EPSC ski club member volunteers will receive the following:

- FREE entrance to the July 24th game
- FREE parking with Parking Voucher (Lot on Pattison Avenue located between Broad St and 20th St. You may walk to the ballpark from this lot or take the free shuttle.)
- Meal ticket worth \$7.50 at the Park's food vendors
- View of the game
- Option to stay for the remainder of the game after the 7th inning
- Green apron (MUST be returned to Phillies at end of game or EPSC will be charged for the missing apron), gloves, trash bags

Our Council and reference to the 35 member ski clubs will be recognized in a pre-game announcement that night.

All volunteers must be able to stand the entire game and be able to walk up and down the steps between sections **AT THE END OF EACH INNING** to collect recyclable plastic and aluminum bottles until the 7th inning. Volunteers between the ages of 8 and 16 are required to have one adult volunteer for every three children participating.

# Minutes

## April 26, 2011 WSC Council Meeting Minutes Delcastle Golf Club & Restaurant

The meeting was called to order by President Bob Viskup.

Present: Rosella Champion, Sandy Dobbs, Sue Donaldson, Donna Dossett, Marty Drinan, Beth Lovering, JoEll Malloy, Jon Osborn, Ed Talarowski, Craig Wemmers and Lynn Winkler.

**President:** Bob Viskup had nothing to report.

**Vice-president:** Sam sent an email about the upcoming Ski Show at King of Prussia. Jo-Ell Malloy will send the Directory to the current members. There will not be a paper directory.

**Minutes:** The minutes from March 22 were accepted with corrections.

**Treasurer Report:** Donna presented the March Treasurer Report. It was approved.

**Assistant Treasurer Report:** Council discussed the NSF check which cost the Club \$67 for the trip and \$10 for the NSF from the Elk #2 trip. Rosella reported that the Elk #1 was in the black by \$214, Elk #2 paperwork not finished, and Elk #3 in the black by \$500. Utah trip was in the black by \$55, Steamboat in the black by \$1700, Europe in the black by \$441 and Big Sky exactly on budget. The Assistant Treasurer's Report for March were read and approved.

**Meetings:** Beth reported that the June 8 meeting will be the annual picnic starting at 6 pm at Gore Plaza. The Ski Club is providing the hamburgers/ hot dogs/ buns. Members will bring salads and desserts. Refreshments will BYOB. The July 13 and August 10 meetings will also be at the Gore Pavilion courtesy of Jackie Rhein.

**Activities:** There will be two Hobie Cat events again this year. Robin Kershaw will be leader and Jo-Ell Malloy co-leader for July 23. Sue Donaldson will be leader and Lynn Winkler co-leader for August 27. They will have flyers at the June meeting.

**Business:** No report.

**Complaints:** No report.

**Legal:** No Report.

**Membership:** Jo-Ell reported that the current membership is 158 with 59 family, 100 single, 31 children and 28 new members. Jon Osborn proposed using other methods to try to gain new members. Ed Talarowski asked if we could partner with other groups to share the bus expense.

**Newsletter:** Sandy reported no problems.

**Communications:** No report.

**Winter Trips:** Craig discussed the survey recently sent to all members. There were 95 responses from 365 polled. To reduce the price of the Utah trip, it was moved up a week to avoid the Sundance Movie Festival.

**Day Trips:** Nothing to report.

**Racing:** The Race Team had a very good year. Many of the racers had moved up a level in racing ability- silver and gold racers became gold and platinum racers.

**Marketing:** Donna reported no progress toward using the WNJ data.

**Webmaster:** Joe and Sandy are working toward Sandy taking over as webmaster.

**Hotline:** Kathy sent Sam an email about the Magic Jack.

## **WSC TRIP PAYMENT SCHEDULE**

With planning for winter ski trips upon us, we wanted to review the club's "Ski Vacation Trip Payment Policy and Schedule." Sign-ups commence with the September meeting. We have only two payments. Payment #1: at least ½ trip price; Payment #2: balance of trip price (see trip ads for exact amounts). The first payment is due at the time that you sign up, and the second payment is due by October 15.

The trip price increases by \$30 for those who sign up for a trip (or its wait list) after October 15. If you sign up after October 15, the full trip price plus \$30 will be collected at that time.

If the second (October 15) payment is received by the trip leader more than seven days after it is due, the late fee penalty is \$20. In other words, the second payment is due by October 15, so a late fee will be charged if the payment is received after the one week grace period (after October 22). Also, a \$20 penalty fee will be charged for any check returned to the Club's Assistant Treasurer for non-payment by the bank.

The trip leader will inform the trip participant of any late or penalty fees, which must be paid immediately. The trip leader may cancel a member from the trip if full payment, including all applicable penalty fees, is not received by the trip leader within 17 days of the final payment due date (by November 1). If a member is cancelled from the trip for these reasons the member will receive a refund in accordance with the club's Cancellation and Refund Policy. All applicable penalty fees and the cancellation fee will be deducted from the refund. Any Council member and your trip leaders can provide a photocopy of the full Payment Policy and Schedule upon request.

## **WSC TRIP INSURANCE**

Every year at least a few members need to cancel from a trip at the last minute, or are injured on a trip. Unfortunately, there is often a financial loss that just adds insult to injury for those members. The week-long ski trips typically have trip insurance available through their tour operators or travel agents. If you are interested in purchasing trip insurance, ask your trip leader for the information at trip sign-ups. There is generally a purchase deadline, so it is important to ask about it when you sign up. The prices vary, as each trip is contracted with a different tour operator or travel agent, so each trip will have a different insurance policy to offer.

The Council and trip leaders just want to make you aware of the availability of this insurance. As always, this is strictly optional, but as the cost of travel goes up, it may be something for the members to think about. The travel insurance generally provides coverage for such things as necessary cancellation from the trip, lost or delayed luggage, missed flights, emergency medical care, and death or dismemberment (let's not test this one, please).

## **WSC TRIP CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY**

### **What happens when you cancel from a WSC trip?**

According to club policy, the member becomes responsible for financial losses to the trip. (However, if a trip is cancelled by the club for any reason, the club's contingency fund covers non-recoverable losses, and the members receive full refunds.)

If you cancel from a trip, you must submit your cancellation in writing to the trip or activity leader, and your letter must include your handwritten signature. The date the trip or activity leader receives your letter serves as your official cancellation date.

If you cancel from a vacation trip (defined as 5 or more nights) more than 60 days before the trip departure date, and your spot on the trip is filled, you will receive a refund of your money minus the \$50 cancellation fee. If you cancel from a vacation trip 60 days or less from the departure date, you will receive a refund of your money minus \$50 or any non-recoverable and fixed costs, whichever is greater. Any penalty fees you may have incurred will also be deducted.

If you cancel from a weekend trip more than 60 days before departure, and your spot is filled by another member, you will receive a refund minus \$30. If you cancel from a weekend trip 60 days or less from departure, you will receive a refund minus \$30 or any non-recoverable and fixed costs, whichever is greater.

If you cancel from a day trip more than 30 days before the trip date, and your spot is filled, you will receive a refund minus \$10. If you cancel from a day trip 30 days or less from the trip date, you will receive a refund minus \$10 or any non-recoverable and fixed costs, whichever is greater.

Refunds are paid after the trip's final accounting report has been reconciled by the assistant treasurer, typically about one month after the trip has returned. Exception: if the cancellation is from, and more than 60 days before, a vacation trip. In this case the refund will be paid within 30 days of receipt of the cancellation letter.

If a member wants to transfer from one vacation trip to another vacation trip sponsored by the WSC, the cancellation fee will be waived when done before October 15th or more than 90 days before the trip departure date, whichever comes first. Transfers may be done only to an open space, and cancellation from one vacation trip to transfer to another vacation trip must be done on the same day. A transfer to a waiting list is prohibited (the cancellation fees will be charged in such a case).
